



Dividing line

The "confiscation line" drawn up in 1864 for confiscation of Maori land is portrayed by Waikato Institute of Technology Centre for Creative Industries head CK Reynolds in a new installation in Hamilton.

Reynolds photographed the 43km straight line from the air and digitally stitched the photographs together into a 26 metre installation, now on show at the Hamilton Waitakaruru Arboretum and Sculpture Park.

The confiscation line was created after the Waikato Land Wars, and was later used to determine the border between the Waikato and Matamata-Piako districts.

Reynolds' work is part of an exhibition entitled E:SCAPE Sculpture in the Landscape, running until May 25.
