





North Island Regional Numbers of Participants in the Hospitality Industry






South Island Regional Numbers of Participants in the **Hospitality Industry**





Numbers of Participants Employed Across the Retail and Service Sector in New Zealand






Employment Status in the Hospitality Industry










Remuneration of Participants in the Hospitality Industry in the North Island

Remuneration of Participants in the Hospitality Industry in the South Island






Remuneration of Participants in the Hospitality Industry Sectors



Number of Secondary Schools Offering Travel, Hospitality and Tourism as at 1 July 2008


