# *A day in the life of...*



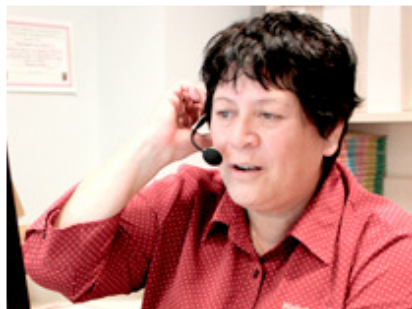
