FREESTORE is a small pop up grocery store. For a fortnight **FREESTORE** will become the collection point for food / waste contributions from Wellington businesses, liaising with charities, schools and community groups to distribute the food. The public will be able to come and browse the store, read about the project and the businesses involved, and they may also take food away with them. By opening to the public **FREESTORE** allows people to view a vital step in the supply chain that shows major efforts being undertaken by businesses to reduce waste and find innovative ways of being active in their communities.
