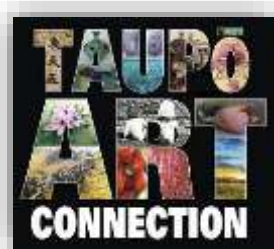
BEAUTIFUL MARKS TAUPŌ ART CONNECTION
